Your Royal Highness,

I am writing to you in regards to our recent summit in Lucina Beach for the discussion of the transfer of sovereignty of Hong Kong from the Kingdom of Lucina to the Republic of Verona. I, as President of the Republic of Verona, am greatly excited on the behalf of the nation I represent and the people of Hong Kong for this opportunity, and the prosperity it will bring to the region.

I would once again like to detail the conditions of this transfer of sovereignty, as suggested by the Republic of Verona:

- (i) The entirety of the territories of Hong Kong Island, the Kowloon peninsula (henceforth referred to as “Kowloon”), and the New Territories, shall cease to be under the jurisdiction of the Kingdom of Lucina, and shall be administered by the Republic of Verona;
- (ii) These aforementioned territories to be transferred shall become a Remote Prefecture of the Republic of Verona, named *Hong Kong Remote Prefecture*, and will retain its previous customs and way of life from under its previous rule, and shall enjoy a degree of autonomy such that the people of Hong Kong are guaranteed the right to

- freely elect local government officials to choose their own policies partially detached from the direct administration of the Republic of Verona government in Verona City;
- (iii) Upon the transfer of sovereignty of the territories, the next heir to the position of Princess of Hong Kong, the daughter of Her Royal Highness Sylphyn Ford Tachibana II, who is now Sylphyn Ford Tachibana II, shall be appointed to the position of Chief Executive of Hong Kong, the highest political office in the local government of the Hong Kong Remote Prefecture;
 - (iv) All previous ceremonial styles and titles from the Kingdom of Lucina shall be inherited to their greatest realistic extents, i.e. the Chief Executive shall retain the ceremonial style of “(Her/His/Their) Royal Highness”;
 - (v) Miss Tachibana III shall remain with a scheduled term in office until elections to choose her successor are held, no later than 05 December 2026;
 - (vi) New citizens and any current residents of Hong Kong who apply to become citizens of the Hong Kong Remote Prefecture will in turn be full and free citizens of the Republic of Verona, albeit with a separate passport that guarantees the right of permanent abode, the right to work, and the right to study in the Remote Prefecture as well as the entirety of the Republic of Verona, with the exception of any future separate Remote Prefectures, for which these rights will be evaluated separately; and
 - (vii) Current residents and/or citizens of Hong Kong under the Kingdom of Lucina may retain and indefinitely renew their Kingdom of Lucina passports, and may hold these passports alongside their Hong Kong Remote Prefecture passports.

I would like to invite you, Princess Sylphyn Ford Tachibana II of Lucina, as well as Her Majesty Queen Lucina I, to a conference in Verona City on 01 November 2025 to formally

review and refine these terms, and to decide on the date at which the transfer of sovereignty will occur.
